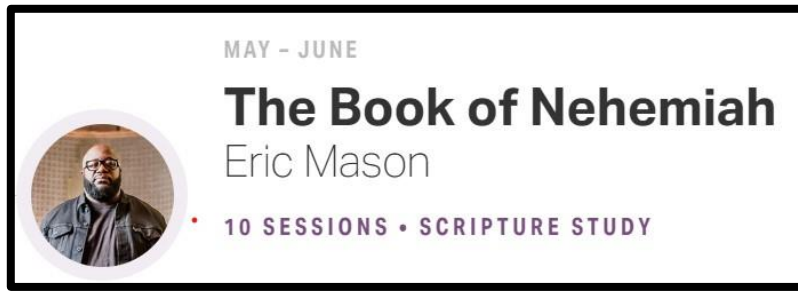
Lost Cause
